Homicide group to hold first vigil since 2019

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – News media are invited to cover the Survivors of Homicide Support Group's 22nd annual Candlelight Vigil and Service of Remembrance at 6:30 p.m. Friday, Dec. 10, at St. Andrews Presbyterian Church, 712 Wappoo Road, Charleston. This is a time for people who lost loved ones to homicide or other fatal incidents to remember and honor the victims. Attached is an invite that was sent to the survivors.

The support group is a collaboration between the MUSC National Crime Victims Research & Treatment Center and the Office of Victim Services at the Charleston County Sheriff's Office. The event is presented in partnership with Coastal Crisis Chaplaincy.
